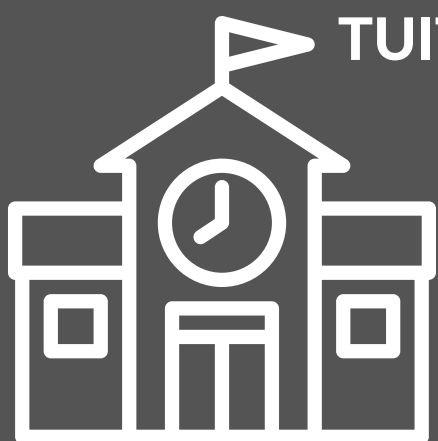

AVERAGE MONTHLY TUITION

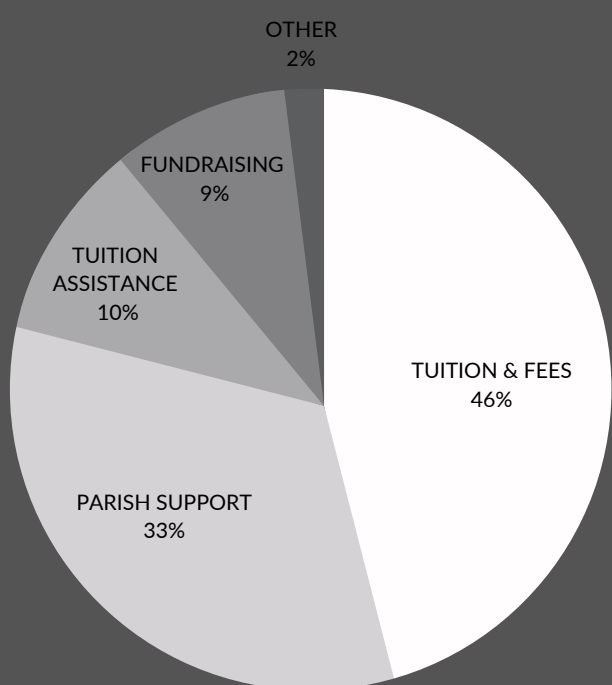


\$301
